

Hello everyone,

Well it's been another busy week here at St Philip's filled with a wealth of learning opportunities for our children.

It was lovely to see so many of you at our 'Meet the Teacher' event this week. Later in the half term, we will be having a parent pop in which we hope you can join us for too. This will be an opportunity for you to come into your child's classroom and enjoy a story with them towards the end of the school day.

Over the next few weeks we will be talking to the children about how 'School is the place to be', focusing on how important it is to be here on time each day and introducing prizes for those who are. The law entitles every child of compulsory school age the right to education which means that they must attend each day unless they are ill or in exceptional circumstances. I have had a number of requests for holidays during term time. Under current legislation, schools are now only allowed to authorise leave of absence if satisfied that exceptional circumstances exist. I must therefore advise you that any unauthorised absence could result in Education Penalty Notice fines of £60 (rising to £120) per parent per child being issued by the local authority.

In recent years, there has been a great deal of research into the impact of attendance. Without 96%+ attendance in school, research suggests it is highly unlikely that children will develop good mental health, strong wellbeing, secure healthy relationships and go on to live a full and physically healthy life Here at St Philip's we want the best for all of our children and understand that some find it harder than others to attend school. Therefore at all stages, we aim to work with pupils and parents to remove any barriers by working together to put the right support in place.
